Why Does Hebrew Day Require a Uniform?

We are proud of our new school wide uniform policy in part because it:

- Improves student behavior at school
- Instills a sense of unity, belonging, school spirit and pride
- Reduces peer pressure to out-dress one another
- Engenders a feeling of comfort and security, fostering greater empathy and kindness

Just as adults dress professionally for work, differentiating learning clothes from play clothes encourages students to focus and learn when at school.

All students in grades K-8 are required to adhere to the uniform policy. No colors or sweatshirts other than those included in the uniform are permitted to be worn inside the building. Students dressed in clothes not consistent with this policy will not be allowed to remain in class. Parents will be notified and asked to provide an appropriate uniform before their child rejoins their classmates.

WE STRONGLY URGE YOU TO LABEL ALL CLOTHING

Any uniform policy questions/concerns will be addressed by a member of the administration.

Girls

Skirts:

Navy Blue or Khaki skirts at least 2 inches below the knee.

Leggings:

Solid grey, navy blue, white or black leggings can be worn under skirts.

Hair:

No bleach, color or tinted hair.

Jewelry and Make-up:

Should be subdued and at the parent's discretion.

Shoes:

Sneakers, athletic shoes, Maryjane style shoe with socks.

Boys

Kippot:

Must be worn at all times. Students are required to bring extra kippot at the beginning of the year, along with their school supplies. Students who do not come with their own kippot will receive one for a \$1 fee.

Pants:

Navy blue or khaki Docker style pants, no cargo pants.

Shorts (Kinder - 3rd ONLY):

Navy blue or Khaki

Hair:

Should be well groomed and above the collar. No extreme haircuts or hair dye is acceptable.

Shoes: Sneakers or athletic shoes with socks.

All Students

Polos:

Heather Grey, Navy Blue or Pink

Sleeve length must go mid length between the shoulder and elbow or can be long sleeve.

Sweaters/Sweatshirts:

Plain navy blue ONLY. Sweaters can be button down, V-neck, crew neck or zipper. Sweatshirts can be crew neck, pullover or zipper **WITHOUT** A HOOD. Navy blue fleece pullover or zip-up may also be worn **WITHOUT** A HOOD.

No logos are allowed, unless it's the school embroidered logo.

Outerwear:

Heavy jackets and rain jackets of choice may be worn while outside at recess.

What types of things are NOT okay?

- Hoodies and hats.
- No non-school logos, designs, embellishments, patterns, prints or colored trimmings.
- No oversized earrings or necklaces. Small studs or ½ inch hoops only.
- No chains or oversized buckles.
- No jeans, skinny or pencil pants/skirts, sweatpants, stretch pants, tank tops or sleeveless tops.
- No sagging, dragging, baggies, or bare midriff.
- No open toes, heels, flip flops, wheels, or open back shoes.

Special Exceptions / Special Occasions:

On special occasion days and on school trips when free dress is allowed, rules of modesty must still be followed.

On "spirit days" students are allowed to wear spirit clothing. Spirit clothing includes "Husky T-Shirts", Science Fair T-Shirts, Wild Animal Park Trip T-Shirts, etc.

The Following Changes Can be Expected for the 2020/21 School Year:

1. Khaki will NOT be a color option for skirts, shorts or pants.
2. Polos will be limited to grey and navy blue ONLY and must have the school logo embroidered.
3. Polos will be available from one or more vendors online and we will also work with a local embroiderer so you can bring in your already purchased grey or navy blue polos.
4. Outerwear will also require a school logo and will be available from one or more vendors online.
5. School Logos will not include the name of the school, only the logo picture.
6. Middle School will be required to purchase and wear a separate PE uniform on PE days.

Girls

Skirts:

Navy Blue skirts at least 2 inches below the knee.

Leggings:

Solid grey, navy blue, white or black leggings can be worn under skirts.

Hair:

No bleach, color or tinted hair.

Jewelry and Make-up:

Should be subdued and at the parent's discretion.

Shoes:

Sneakers, athletic shoes, Maryjane style shoe with socks.

Boys

Kippot:

All Students

Polos:

Heather Grey with Navy Blue Logo or Navy Blue with White Logo

Sleeve length must go mid length between the shoulder and elbow or can be long sleeve.

Sweaters/Sweatshirts:

Plain navy blue ONLY with White School Logo. Sweaters can be button down, V-neck, crew neck or zipper. Sweatshirts can be crew neck, pullover or zipper **WITHOUT** A HOOD. Navy blue fleece pullover or zip-up may also be worn **WITHOUT** A HOOD. All outerwear must have the school logo embroidered in white.
