

# Hebrew Day Preschool Summer 2020

## Guidelines at a Glance

**We're following best practices guidelines provided by the Center for Disease Control (CDC), American Camp Association (ACA), and state and local regulatory agencies (collectively "The Regulatory Agencies").**

### At Camp:

- 5-10 Children per group
- 2 Teachers (wearing masks)
- No Intermingling
- Outdoor Play Scheduled
- Bathroom Times Scheduled
- Cleaned After Use
- Bring disposable lunch, snack, and water (no backpacks)
- Spray-on Sunscreen and Face Stick
- 2 Changes of clothes and shoes left at school
- Children and Faculty in the building only

### Drop Off & Pick Up: **Make allowances for a longer drop off and pick up.**

#### **Plan accordingly please.**

- Staggered Drop Off: 8:45am, 9:00am, 9:15am
- Staggered Pick Up: 12:45pm, 1:00pm, 1:15pm
- Drop off and pick up outside
- Drive Thru
- Parent driver only
- One Parent helping child only
- Health and Temperature Check
- Hand Sanitizing
- No aftercare or early care
- Late pick up still results in a \$1 per minute fee.

## Drop Off & Wellness Check:

Each morning at drop-off your child will have a health check. You and your camper will stay in your car and then be directed to an area where you will be greeted by a staff member who will conduct a health screening with a no-touch thermometer.

Children with temperatures over **100 degrees** are not permitted to attend camp. We also ask that parents take their own temperature at home to safely take part in our carpool system. Any parents not feeling well or having a temperature over **100 degrees**, please stay home. After the temperature check, children will sanitize their hands and walk to their camp group.

## Prevention & Policies

We're following best practices guidelines provided by the Center for Disease Control (CDC), American Camp Association (ACA), and state and local regulatory agencies (collective regulatory agencies).

- Physical distancing when possible
- Outdoor activity when possible
- Individual supplies when possible
- Increased hand washing for staff and students
- All supplies used will be sanitized
- Enhanced non-toxic sanitizing throughout the day
- Sick child isolated, 1 hour max pickup

All camp staff will be involved in systematic and regular cleaning of all camp areas. Each group will have designated space indoors and outdoors to limit their contact with other groups. Staff will all conduct frequent cleaning of all common surfaces including but not limited to door handles, restroom fixtures, chairs, and tables.

## Follow up

- Please bring 2 changes of clothes and shoes left at school.
- Any child who appears sick (determined by preschool) will be sent home. Sick children will be isolated and need to be picked up within the hour.
- Any child with a cough or fever will be required to bring a doctor's clearance in order to return to camp.
- Children must be home for 72 hours before returning to camp if excluded by preschool for appearing sick.
- Schedule your drop off and pick up times
- Signed COVID-19 waivers are required
- Anyone traveling from out of the country must self-quarantine for 14 days prior to joining camp.
