

## Hebrew Day Travel Policy (Updated 3/1/2021)

All travel, even that of a household member, must be reported on our travel plans form. We are asking all families to confirm travel plans outside of California, so that we can better plan for in-person attendance.

### In State Travel

- No additional quarantine or testing requirement to resume in-person learning, although we encourage families to get tested after returning from any travel.
- Students and Staff will still need to adhere to all regular school procedures, including any quarantine or testing recommendations upon returning from school vacations (e.g., Winter Break).

### Domestic Travel

- All students and staff, preschool - 8th grade, who travel outside of the State of California will be required to quarantine for 14 days upon return.
- Those who can provide a negative COVID-19 PCR test result may return to in-person learning 7 days after returning from travel. A COVID-19 test should be taken 5-7 days after back in San Diego, or later.
- All K-8 students are eligible for distance learning during quarantine times.

### International Travel

- All students and staff, preschool - 8th grade, who travel outside of the country, including Hawaii, Alaska, Mexico and Canada, will be required to quarantine for **14 days** upon return,
  - As an example, if you return from travel on April 5th, the last day of quarantine would be April 19th, and you could end quarantine and return to school on April 20th.
- A negative COVID-19 PCR test result will be required to return to in-person learning after the 14 day quarantine. A COVID-19 test should be taken 5-7 days after back in San Diego, or later.
- K-8 students are eligible for distance learning during quarantine times.

## Other Reminders

- Regardless of travel, always follow good hygiene practices: wear masks, maintain distance, avoid gatherings, and wash hands frequently.
- All K-8 students may participate in virtual distance learning during any quarantine times.
- Please be aware that travel restrictions may change, and testing availability and results are sometimes delayed. This may unexpectedly impact when your child can resume in-person learning.
